



## 2022 ANNUAL REPORT - SPECIAL PROJECTS

#### RIDE UNITED: LAST MILE DELIVERY

Since its inception in April of 2020, Interface 211 Ventura County's DoorDash food and pet food delivery program, Ride United: Last Mile Delivery has made over 11,000 deliveries in Ventura County. The delivery program aims to help bridge the food gap for those with transportation, medical, or other challenges that can create barriers to getting groceries home due to access and functional needs.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Ventura County residents experienced many new hardships, including struggling to provide for their pets. 211VC donated nearly \$20,000 in PetSmart gift cards to various animal shelters across the county to support new pet owners who adopt from these shelters and has delivered over 3,000 bags of free pet food to community members in need.



Ride United Last Mile Delivery and its pet food delivery project, Pets Eat Too (PET), is a partnership between Interface 211 Ventura County, DoorDash, United Way, Humane Society of Ventura County, Kirby Subaru of Ventura, Cassie's Cats, Full Throttle Kustomz, The Salvation Army, Community Action of Ventura County, Ruben Castro Charities, HELP of Ojai, and Catholic Charities of Ventura County.


